## **Vinification:**

Classic red vinification of pressed and destalked grapes. The wine matures in steel casks and is bottled about a year after the harvest. It is the estate's whimsical wine, created from a blend of numerous and varied grapes which, in spite of their diversity, work well together.

## **Character:**

Everything about this wine supports the name "Augurio" which means "good omen" for the wine - from its nose of ripe fruit to the burst of flavors. Whatever your varietal preference, you'll find it in this "Super-Blend" of Bonarda, Barbera, Pinot Noir, Syrah, Cabernet and Merlot. A magnificent balancing act and a real crowd pleaser –

## **Palate & Nose:**

The colour is typically brilliant ruby red. There are fresh, fragrant aromas of red fruit with notes of flowers and hay. On the palate, the wine displays an enjoyable persistence dominated by the fine balance between the tannins and its typical, fresh acidity.
