Vinification:

We harvest the grapes in late autumn when they are well ripened. They undergo classic red wine vinification. Then the wine enters a prolonged period of delicate refinement in oak barrels and barriques.

Character:

A big red wine created from ancient vines bearing three grape varietals that typify the tradition of Oltrepo Pavese: Barbera, Uva Rara and Croatina. This is a wine of great body and structure, strong and forthright, yet alluring and elegant with its depth of colour and generosity of bouquet. Its character celebrates the fusion of the grapes' noble qualities with the winemaker's wisdom.

A big-hearted, generous wine that lifts the spirits like the most heroic of legends !!!!

Palate & Nose:

It has a deep ruby red set off by glints of light. On the nose, an intense, clean and refined array of aromas opens with plum, black cherry and blackberry to be followed by blueberry, liquorice, cyclamen and vanilla. The complex perfume marries the fragrances of autumn and jam with delicate hints of vanilla and plants that develop into a generous, intense and ethereal bouquet.

In the mouth, it is full, smooth, warm and satisfying with notes of mature fruit and delicate floral touches that lead to the gentle tannins of the long aftertaste. The finish is persistent with flashbacks to plum and black cherry.
